

## Riding The Bus

Note: The Cross loves to be able to provide transportation for it's Youth in order to participate in special events. While riding the bus may be fun to you it can also be dangerous. It is very important that you obey the rules outlined below so that you can have a safe and enjoyable trip. Below is the list of things we expect from every youth/chaperone riding on our bus.

1. No youth can ride the bus without a permission slip.
2. No heads and/or hands out the windows.
3. Everybody must stay seated and facing the front of the bus.
4. Seatbelts must be worn while the bus is moving.
5. No cursing
6. No loud speaking/yelling
7. No hitting, kicking, or bullying other riders.
8. Respect the driver and leaders.
9. Do not exit the bus until given permission to do so.

## While On Church Grounds Or Away At Special Outings

Note: You are the responsibility of the Church while on church property. Our leaders/volunteers do an excellent job of watching and protecting you during our services. It is very important that you help make your visit at The Cross safe by listening and obeying those in authority. Your safety is our number one priority. Below is a list of things we expect from each one of our youth while on the church property.

1. You must stay in designated areas. (Youth room, Fellowship Hall, Sanctuary, Church grounds)
2. Do not go where an adult is not.
3. Under no circumstances are you to leave the church property unless with a parent or guardian (unless prior arrangements are made).
4. No fighting
5. No public display of Affection
6. No cursing
7. No bullying
8. Do not disrespect authority
9. Treat the church/visiting property and equipment with respect. (Do not damage property.)

## Class Time

Note: Class time is a time set aside to learn what God has to say from His Word. The leaders, Bible and volunteers are to always be respected. We try to make this class time fun and interesting so that you will enjoy learning. Below is a list of rules & guidelines created by the Crossfire Youth. These are expected of everyone attending class, to make it a memorable and a fun place for everyone to learn.

1. Transition to class time quietly and orderly. Other services are going on at the same time.
2. Respect the teacher and other adult workers.
3. Obey authority.
4. No yelling
5. No public display of affection
6. No horseplay
7. No arguing with the teacher
8. No cursing
9. No using God's name in vain
10. No holding hands unless in prayer
11. Clean up after yourself
12. Respect the space of others
13. Listen to the teacher.
14. No talking while the teacher is talking.
15. No use of phones while in class.
